

Library eBooks Kindle Paperwhite

(Includes Kindle Books for Kindle Fire)



Getting Started:

- You will need a **computer/device with an Internet connection**, your **Kindle Paperwhite**, and your **library card**. *You may need your **Kindle USB cable** if your device does not have WiFi capabilities.
- If your Kindle has WiFi capabilities, connect it to a WiFi network before you begin.
- Go to **isliplib.org**, go to the **free downloads tab**, and click on **eBooks & Audiobooks**. Alternatively, you can go directly to: **https://livebrary.overdrive.com**
- Please note:** Audiobooks are not available for Kindle Paperwhite devices. Kindle Fire tablets can access audiobooks using the OverDrive app. See Kindle Fire instructions for app setup.

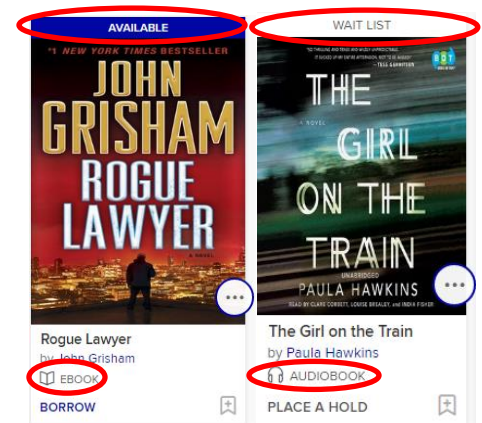
Your Account and Loan Period:

- Click on **Sign In** in the upper right corner.
- Select **Islip Public Library**, and then enter your **library barcode number & Pin / Password**.
- Click on **my account** (upper right corner).
- Your loan period is automatically set to 14 days. You have the option to change this loan period to 7 or 21 days.
- Tap on **Settings**. Under lending periods, tap on desired **loan period** for each format, this setting will automatically save.

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- Click on **Subjects** to browse by genre.
- When searching for books, be sure to look at the top of each book cover to check its availability. Under the book cover check the item's format for eBook, audiobooks will not work.
- When it says available above the book cover, the title is immediately available and you can **borrow** the book.
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- Connect your device to the computer with the **USB cable**. Your device will be listed in the same place an external drive would appear.
 - Windows**: Your device will appear under **This PC**, **Computer** or **My Computer**.
 - Mac**: Your device will appear on the **desktop**.
- Open the **device folder**, and then open the **Documents** or **Internal Documents** folder.
- Paste** the file into the **Documents folder for Kindle Paperwhite** / Books folder for Kindle Fire.
- Safely **disconnect your device** from your computer once the transfer has completed. Go to the **bookshelf** or **books** page on your device to access your books.

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
